



Maria Curie-Skłodowska Birthday Card Competition

Role: You are a student in ATUT Primary School, WIS or International High School of Wrocław. You have been asked to write a birthday card for Maria Curie-Skłodowska.

Audience: You need to imagine that Maria Curie-Skłodowska will receive and read your birthday card. She is 67 years old and it is her last birthday.

Situation: In a secret lab in Warsaw there is a time machine which makes it possible to send messages into the past. It's a great opportunity to appreciate the life and work of great scientists, leaders and artists.

Since it is 2017 and it's Maria Curie-Skłodowska's 150th birthday anniversary you were asked to create a birthday card for this amazing person.

The card will be delivered on her last birthday - November 7th 1934.

Product of performance: The card is in English or in Polish and it consists of an image and a text.

The technique used for producing the image is your choice so the image can be hand drawn or it can be a photograph or a collage. Whatever form you believe to be suitable for the card. The only requirement is for the image to be connected with the life and work of Maria Curie-Skłodowska.

The text needs to include:

- appreciation of at least two of her scientific achievements (you need to focus on how they influence our lives today),
- a reflection on what her life and achievements make you think or understand,
- personalized birthday wishes to Maria Curie-Skłodowska
- A signature.

What's the prize?

The jury will evaluate all submitted cards and the prize will be given to the best one.

When is the deadline?

Monday, November 6th by lunch break (13:00).

Where do I submit my card?
